## Little tie

Nice, quick and interesting project to use some leftover yarn. Needles 3 mm (US 2.5) Size. 4 cm x 150 cm (2.5 in. x 59 in.).

Cast on 9 sts. Follow chart. If you would like to make it a bit wider, just add more (knit) sts where the red lines are.

In WS rows 8, 10, 12 and 14 the decrease at the beginning is an S1K1PSSO and the one at the end is a twisted purl decrease.

VK AK

Knit.

Purl.

Yarn Over.

S1K1PSSO = 1Slip one Knit one and pass slipped st over knitted st.

K2tog

(edge st) slip 1 st knitwise with yarn in front, bring yarn to back and continue with the next (knit) st.



(edge st) Knit twisted by inserting your ndl through back leg of st.

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Purl 2 together twisted by inserting your ndl from back to front through back legs of both sts.

M Pick up yarn bridge between last knit st and edge stitch with your left ndl and knit twisted (through back leg of loop)..





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
